

## Medicaid Reimbursement Billing Codes for Asthma Care Services by State

The billing code examples provided in the Medicaid Reimbursement Billing Codes for Asthma Care Services by State guide represent what is reimbursed by Medicaid within various states. This applies both to the type of provider delivering the service as well as the service itself (home-based asthma education, home assessments, and products that support environmental management of asthma triggers). Review the list to see what is covered across different states, and then use this information to engage stakeholders in your state to advocate for expanded Medicaid and private payer reimbursement.

With many states exploring the possibility of sustainable financing, this guide will be updated as more programs secure reimbursement. <b>Massachusetts</b>	
<i>The Massachusetts health care system, <a href="#">MassHealth</a>, utilizes the Massachusetts Childrens High Risk Asthma Bundled Payment Demonstration Program. The program refers to the following ACA provisions:</i>	
<b>S2704</b>	Demonstration project to evaluate integrated care around hospitalization
<b>S3023</b>	National pilot program on payment bundling
<b>S2706</b>	Pediatric Accountable Care Organization Demonstration Project
<b>Michigan</b>	
<i>The <a href="#">Asthma Network of West Michigan</a> bills on a fee-for-service basis for home visits, including school visits or visits with a primary care provider to review the Asthma Action Plan. The program uses the following Revenue Code:</i>	
<b>551</b>	Skilled nursing for home visits (nurses, respiratory therapists, or masters-level social workers)
<b>Missouri</b>	
<i>While not yet opened, the following procedure and billing codes are proposed for the Missouri health care system:</i>	
<b>T1028</b>	Home assessments for suitability of home environment
<b>S9441</b>	Asthma education by non-physician provider (also used as a benefit for CRCP-CCP services)
<b>E199</b>	Miscellaneous- covers encasements and vacuum reimbursement
<b>98960</b>	Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified non-physician (used as a benefit for CRCP-CCP)
<b>Oregon</b>	
<b>Multnomah County</b>	
<i>The <a href="#">Multnomah County health care program</a> is currently billing fee-for-service with plans to merge services into the ACA managed care in about a year. The following billing code is utilized:</i>	
<b>T1017</b>	Targeted case management
